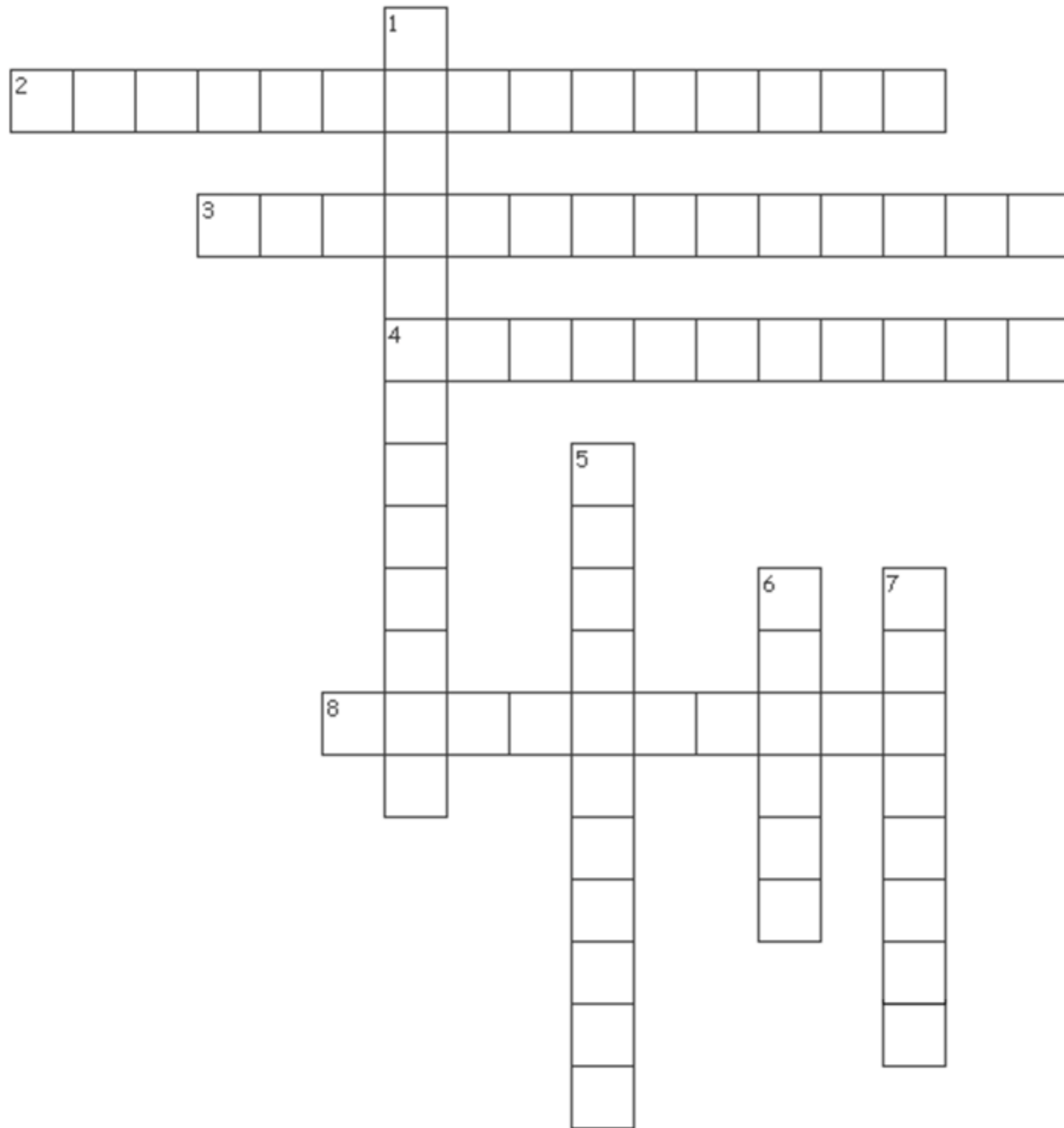


WWII in Springfield and Beyond
