What is this event?

Who can attend?

All Missouri K–12 educators! Whether you're new to teaching or a seasoned pro, you're welcome to join us as a trivia team member or audience participant. This includes teachers, administrators, aides/paras, librarians, and counselors. **We just ask that you show your School ID or email upon arrival.**

Will I get to visit the museum?

The event will be hosted in the Historic Fox Theatre next door to the museum. **Early check-in to the event is available for all participating teachers at the museum from 2 - 4 PM.** You are welcome to visit the museum's 7 galleries anytime from 2 - 4 PM for free, and then join us in the Fox for trivia!

Unable to come early, don't worry! All participants will walk away from the evening with a free museum pass to come back and see us another time.

FOR TEAM PARTICIPANTS

How do I sign up for a team?

Use the "Sign Up Your Team" link on our website (<https://historymuseumonthesquare.org/product/teachers-trivia-night/>).

Each team should have exactly 4 players. Team registration must be completed by 4 PM on August 13th.

Is there a cost to participate?

Nope—it's completely free!

Do we need to study ahead of time?

Trivia will focus on Springfield and Missouri history and fun facts. No studying required—just bring your curiosity and team spirit! Although, a visit to the museum ahead of time would be a fun local history refresher. (Visit for free from 2 - 4 PM prior to the event.)

What can teams win?

All teams are guaranteed prizes!

Can I sign up as a partial team or solo?

We recommend signing up as a full team of 4. If you're solo or can't find a team, you're welcome to join as an audience participant (see below)!

FOR AUDIENCE PARTICIPANTS

Do I need to register to attend as an audience member?

Registration is appreciated but not required. Come on by!

Can audience members win prizes too?

Yes! There will be a group trivia round just for the audience, with the chance to win fun prizes.

Relaxed, welcoming, and upbeat. Think educator happy hour meets trivia night in a historic setting.

Where should I park?
